"Why should I attend my live classes?"

- Live class-connects is where the learning happens
- Your teacher is available to answer questions & help
- Higher chance of graduating high school

"What if I skip one or two classes today?"

- You will be reported as partially absent
- Your Learning Coach will be notified
- Will miss out on class content & homework information
- Negative influence on your grades

"I'm too tired or busy to attend classwhat will happen?"

- You will be reported as absent for a full day, Learning Coach is notified
- It is your responsibility to make up for the lost class time & homework, find recordings, reach out to your teachers, etc.

"How does going to class help my future?"

- More likely to graduate and have better employment opportunities
- Higher salary
- Better benefits
- Life skills & knowledge that will apply outside of the classroom

Attendance Notices & Policies:

- ✓ Students are required to attend school for a minimum of 6 hours per school day to be considered attending a full day (both homework/assignment minutes and class-connect time count towards this minimum)
- ✓ You will receive a truancy warning after 3 / 5 / 7+ days of partial or full unexcused absences in the form of an email, phone call, and/or physical letter
- ✓ Steps will be taken to resolve the issue
 - o Absenteeism Prevention Policy
 - o Potential county involvement will occur if chronic truancy is an issue

Missing just 2 days per month means a student misses 10% of the school year. The academic impact of missing school whether excused or unexcused is the same.

80% of success is showing up.
